Is hydropower a cornerstone of South America's energy infrastructure?

Providing 45% of electricity supply in South America, hydropower stands “as a cornerstone of the region’s energy infrastructure”, the International Hydropower Association reports in its 2024 World Hydropower Outlook.

Is hydropower a threat to South America's Future?

Hydropower remains a cornerstone of South America’s energy mix, providing 45% of the continent’s electricity in 2023. Yet, as the International Hydropower Association's 2024 report highlights, ageing infrastructure, climate change impacts, and declining foreign investment threaten its future.

How does South America generate electricity?

South America’s electricity generation strongly depends on the availability of water resources for hydropower and thermoelectric power generation.

Which country has the most wind energy in South America?

Brazil has also led the growth of wind energy in South America over the past decade. The country’s total installed wind energy capacity was 14.4GW in 2018, accounting for 77.4% of the region’s total capacity.

What percentage of Latin America's electricity comes from hydropower?

Which countries are focusing on hydropower development in South America?

Currently only utilising about 20% of its estimated hydropower potential, to help support further development, Argentina has implemented several policies

and incentives including feed-in tariffs and PPAs specially targeting small hydro schemes up to 30MW. Another country in South America to watch, according to the IHA, is Bolivia.

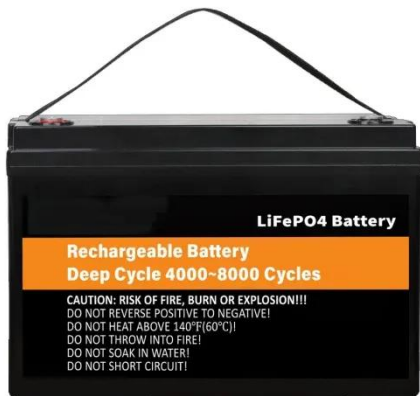

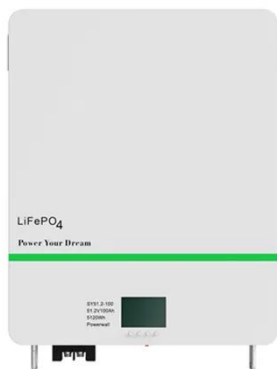

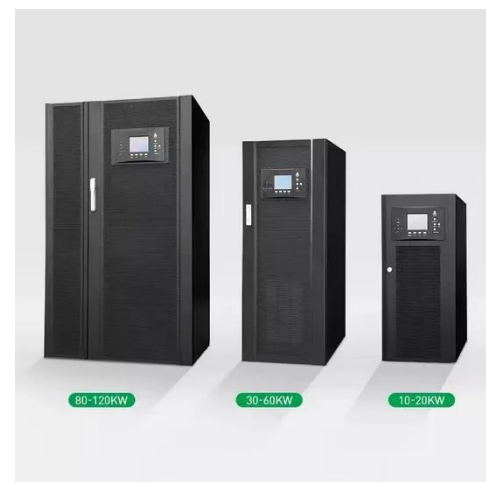
